Secretary: Dear Area, It seems like a long time since Area. Welcome back everyone. First I want to say that I had a couple of errors in the minutes. One, I had sent a correction on who motioned to end the Convention this year. I had mentioned the wrong group, but corrected that. Another one was brought to my attention and that was that I had mentioned a group here, that wasn't for the Convention meeting. Sunday – East Side Recovery, was not present. From SCASO: (No written report – oral). A.S.O. is struggling. We will not owe World after this month, but we need to be buying, not buying on a credit line. We can't get ahead that way. We are working on ways to improve. We have only 5 people to help out. We can't do anything with only 5 people. We cannot have a yard sale when most people live outside Des Moines. We need support of our Area. We need to go back to our groups and ask to help each other out. This is a Storehouse, we can't get alternative merchandise when this is used as a store house. We will be making changes. There will be a dead bolt on the door. We can't have people just taking literature. We couldn't pay the full bill that we ordered. Hopefully we will straighten it out. We want to have extra books before Area starts. Scott stepped up today to help the ASO. We had good sales today. World service will be paid off, so we can order again. We have Spanish literature and supplies now. We are out of round chips. When we give subcommittees a 10% discount, we are making ourselves 6% behind. We make 4% on what sales we make to this area, therefore we lose 6% if we give 10% - no more special rate. We can't give a 10% discount anymore. The rent was raised to Area by \$25.00 and in January it will raise another \$25.00. Thank you, Randy J.

Emily asked about keeping the orders simple and she wanted to know who decided on the 10% discount. It has to stop.
